telc exams at EURASIA Institute

How can I sign up for an exam?

If you are taking a course at EURASIA during the registration period, please fill in the relevant application form and hand it in at our Education Office (room 15).

If you are not a EURASIA course participant during the registration period, please come in person to our Education Office. You will need to bring the examination fee as well as the completed telc application form.

Please note the registration deadlines as well as our opening hours.

What can I do if I have missed the registration deadline?

You can still register with us up to 9 working days before the examination.

This service costs an extra fee of €30.

What does it cost to take a telc exam?

(Costs of the exam with a minimum of 4 examinees)

How can I prepare for the exams? Is there a special telc preparation course?

- All of the EURASIA intensive German courses automatically include a well-designed preparation for the test formats and content.

What do I need to consider on the day of the exam?

Approximately one week before the exam you will receive an exam schedule.

This schedule you can also find on the notice board in the institute.

Please make sure that you do not have any further appointments on the exam day.

What am I allowed to take into the exam with me?

telc exams are to be written in pencil. Please bring soft pencils, a pencil sharpener and a clean eraser.

When will I get the results of my telc exam?

The results of the exam are available approximately 4 weeks after you take the exam. You can pick up the certificate at the institute in the Education Office. You will need to show your ID card.

Opening hours are daily from 11:45 – 3:00 pm.

Is it okay for somebody else to pick up my certificate?

Yes. The person must have a signed power of attorney as well as a copy of your ID card. They will need to bring their own ID card with them also.

Is it possible to have my certificate sent?

Yes. To use this service, you will need to register and pay:

Domestic postage processing: €5

International postage per registered mail: €10

Is it possible to repeat a telc exam?

You can repeat a complete telc exam as often as you like, provided that you pay the examination fee.

For the levels B1 – C1 it is possible to repeat the written and oral tests as isolated exam components within one calendar year after completion of the first exam. It is not however possible to repeat other subtests (reading comprehension / listening comprehension, etc).

Is the telc B1 accepted for my application for German citizenship?

Yes.

Can I apply for university or Studienkolleg with the telc certificate?

If you pass the telc C1 Hochschule exam you can apply to almost all universities which accept this exam as an alternative to a TestDaF or DSH certificate.

If you are unsure as to whether the telc exam will be accepted by your chosen Studienkolleg or university, please check with our colleagues from Student Services /University Placement, as this varies from region to region and from university to university.
